Dear Parishioners,

As we begin another New Year, I would like to take the opportunity to wish you a very happy 2015. I was very pleased with all the attendances over Christmas with all of the Masses well supported. Next year we will consider an extra 4.00pm Mass on Christmas Eve at St Augustine's, as this would be a help to families with young children and help spread the numbers over Christmas Eve. The ceremonies went very well and I would like to thank all of those who prepared the music and singing, those who help with Altar serving and the army of people who prepared the Church, these include our sacristans, cleaners, brass and silver cleaners, flower arrangers, church wardens and collectors, those responsible for the displays and cribs and those who launder the servers and Priest's vestments, as well as those who helped as readers and Eucharistic ministers. All of these people played a vital role in making sure things went well and we the Priests and Deacons really value this help throughout the year. This week the schools return and parish groups get back to their normal programme this week and next, please check the Newsletter for details.

We will start to finalise arrangements for the Lourdes trip in May and we will collect the next instalment towards the final total of £550. Could we ask pilgrims to pay £250 as the next instalment by January  $30^{\rm th}$  at the Parish Office and the final instalment of £275 will be due at the end of April.

The Talks on the Faith will start again on Wednesday  $14^{\rm th}$  January and the theme will be on "Jesus Our Saviour". The talks will then be every Wednesday to make sure that we finish the course in time for Easter and for people to be received into the Catholic Church at the Easter Vigil.

The classes for children at non-catholic schools will resume again on Tuesday  $13^{\rm th}$  January, 2015 at 5.00pm.

As the New Year begins, we will look at some new plans for the Parish. Now that we are blessed with four Deacons and two Priests, we are looking at dividing the Parish into various areas and organising some house to house visiting and updating our Parish Census and records. The new Diocesan Directory shows that we now have the largest Mass attendance in the Diocese, but it is important not to be complacent and to reach out to those who are lapsed from their faith and to invite new members

to the faith. We all have a part to play in this. Many years ago the Parish had a very efficient system of street wardens and I would like to look at some way of introducing a system of local contacts in the area. We will look at this in more detail over the next month or so. We will also look to increase the numbers of readers and ministers at both churches and look at improving some aspects of music and singing


