Dear Parishioners,

This week's Newsletter will cover for two weeks. 136 of the Parishioners will be in Lourdes and we also have half term, so it seems sensible to have the Newsletter covering the next fortnight. You may wish to keep a copy for next week as well.

Father Andrew will be in Lourdes this weekend and I will join the group on Monday. If you have any remaining petitions for the Shrine at Lourdes then let me have them this weekend, as I am going early Monday morning. We will pray for all our Parishioners and ask that you pray for us on our travels. Father Michael Stack will cover the weekday Masses, Monday to Friday. Please note, no Wednesday morning Mass at St Augustine's. Deacon Joe Patterson will stay in the Presbytery and Deacons Tony and Pat will be also covering, so things should run as normal over the half term. We hope you have a chance for a bit of break and I am sure a few days will be welcome by all those involved in our schools.

Thanks for your great generosity towards the Nepal collection. Your contributions added up to £5,000. We will match this with the same amount from the Parish reserves and we will send off a cheque next week for £10,000 to the CAFOD Nepal Appeal.

This weekend at St Augustine's, we have an International Mass to reflect the theme of Pentecost. We will also have some Bidding Prayers read in different languages at some of the Masses at Christ the King and hope to develop the International nature of the Parish over the next few years with various Masses and events.

The Parish Report is now available and I hope that you have found it interesting. It is a summary version of the report which is eight pages long. It will make for easier reading and we will only produce the full report every five years. The report will also be a good way of us understanding our Parish life and some of our financial responsibilities for the Parish and the wider Diocese. I will take the opportunity to speak about the Parish life and finances after our return from Lourdes.
