Each weekend we have 1500 people coming to Mass but that is only a part of what we do. There are two excellent churches and parish schools, a social centre, a sports centre and many clubs and societies for all age groups. You maybe a catholic already involved in the parish. You maybe someone who has lost links with the parish for various reasons, you maybe living locally and have had little contact with us. You will see that we are involved in many projects and all are welcome to join us.

There are many other Parish groups that meet week by week and it is not possible to list them all but some of these include the Mercia Friendship Club for over fifty's, which meet every Friday during term time, in the Community Centre . You can contact Pat Flanagan on 76335383. An Irish Dancing Group meet every Monday evening in the Community Centre . The Legion of Mary and St Vincent de Paul Society, who arrange to visit people in their homes, especially the sick and elderly also meet regularly. Scripture reflection on Tuesday mornings and the Prayer group on Tuesday evenings. The Knights of St Columba also support social care projects and meet monthly. Sunday evenings at the Community Centre is used as a parish social evening to which everyone is welcome. The bar is open and there is dancing and live music.
