Dear Parishioners,

During the month of November we remember all our faithful departed and we will begin reading from our Book of Remembrance for the Holy Souls. If you wish to have some names included, you can still use the envelopes at the back of church and we will add names to the book. You will see that All Saints is celebrated this Sunday, therefore All Souls Day is moved to this Monday, November 3rd. I know that many people like to attend Mass on All Souls Day as well as All Saints Day, therefore we will have an extra Mass this Monday evening at 7.00pm, so there will be Mass at the normal time of 9.15am on Monday and the extra Mass at 7.00pm. Thank you for your generous support with this. During November we will also remember victims of warfare on Remembrance Sunday which is next weekend. Poppies are available at the back of church. At the end of November, on November 22nd and 23rd we will remember all those who have died during this past year and their names will be read out at all the Masses over that weekend. Friends and relatives are asked to make a special effort to come to Mass that weekend to remember our recently deceased. The 23rd is also the Feast of Christ the King.

As you know we are welcoming Bishop Kenney to the Parish for our Visitation on the weekend of 15th and 16th November. His outline timetable for the weekend is as follows: arrive around lunch time. 1.30 – 3.30pm, visit some of the sick of the parish with some of the Priests and Deacons. 3.30pm, meet Headteachers and School Governors. 4.00pm, tea with various parish groups (fifteen minutes with each group to include Youth Group, SVP, Legion of Mary, Justice and Peace, Pastoral Care, Sports Groups, Mercia Club). Could any parish group leaders see me to arrange their slot between 4.00pm and 5.30pm. Also, during this time we would like him to meet anyone who volunteers in the church as a cleaner, sacristan, church warden, flower arranger, and anyone who does any of the many jobs involved in the life of the parish. If tea time on Saturday isn't good for you, there will be a chance to meet over tea after each of the masses as well. He will celebrate the 6.00pm Mass and meet parishioners afterwards over a cup of tea. 7.30pm interviewing Priests. On Sunday morning he will be at the 9.00am, 10.30am and 12 Noon Masses. After lunch, interviews with four Deacons. 4.00pm, visit Holy Rosary Convent. 4.30pm, tea with Parish Finance Group. 5.30pm, review of visit with Parish Priest. 6.30pm, depart. This timetable is of course flexible but we will try to keep to these timings and could group leaders please confirm that they are able to come along. I ask that you all support us over this weekend and allow the Bishop to see the full life of the parish and the various ways in which so many of you are involved. This will be held on Thursday 13th November at 7.00pm in the Library. At this difficult time we should remember to pray for peace in the Holy Land.

Lourdes is now fully booked, but if you want to join a waiting list, please give your name in at the parish office and if there is enough interest we can arrange another group. Deacon Pat is also arranging trips to Medjugorje in June and October 2015, see poster for details.

The Talks on the Faith continue this Wednesday 5th November and the theme will be on the "Eucharist". The course for new Altar Servers at Christ the King will begin next Friday 7th November 3.45pm-4.45pm and runs for 6 weeks. Classes for Communion and Confirmation children at non-catholic schools will start on Tuesday 11th November at 5.00pm in the Library.
