Dear Parishioners,

As we begin the holiday period, we have produced a Newsletter for the next three weekends. This has all the relevant news and the mass intentions. If there are any alterations because of funerals we will of course let you know. We will print enough to last us for the three weeks but you may wish to save a copy rather than picking up the same version over the next few weeks. The more observant among you will notice that we have had a marble background attached to the tabernacle. I hope you like this. The tabernacle will now stand out rather than being lost in the brick work. We have also had a cross carved on the lectern to match that of the altar and tabernacle plinth. We are very grateful to Pargetters who have paid for this work as a gift to the parish. Father Tom Raftery continues to help us cover the holiday period and is busy visiting around the parish.

We are planning our trip to the Holy Land in September and the Foreign Office will advise us nearer the time about the safety of travelling. Their advice at the moment is that we will be able to travel in September. Please keep the people of the Holy Land in your prayers and pray for a just and peaceful solution.

Thanks to all who have supported our Youth Group this past year, our new Youth Group will start on Tuesday 9th September. I will be writing to all the new Year 7 pupils who will now be eligible to join the Youth Group in September and I hope that parents and older brothers and sisters will encourage them to join up. The Youth Group is very successful and a very important part of building the parish for the future. It also means that we do not lose contact with our young people when they go up to secondary school. We will also be preparing our Youth Group for pilgrimages to Lourdes in 2015 and World Youth Day in Krakow 2016.

After the summer we will begin to get together a rota of drivers for our eight-seater bus. Anyone with a clean licence and over thirty years of age can help. If we have enough volunteers it would mean just doing it twice a year. We would offer lifts to anyone finding it hard to get to church on a Sunday. The bus will also be used for youth and school activities in the week.

I have begun arrangements for the Parish trip to Lourdes next year. This will be May half term, May 23rd to May 29th. The cost will be £550 and we are taking names for the first fifty places. If there is demand we will then book on the next fifty. To secure a place please call in to the office with a £25 deposit as soon as possible. We can then judge the level of interest and make the arrangements accordingly.

The Walking Club will continue to meet at 3.00pm from the car park each Sunday.

We are having our Annual Family Camp from Friday 29th August to Sunday 31st August. The cost is £55 for a family and details are all on the information sheet. We will not have an information evening this year as so many are familiar with the event, but over the next couple of weeks we will have information sheets and booking forms at the back of Church and in the Parish Office and you can also confirm a place by phone or email to the Parish

Office. Book as soon as you like and nearer the time we will have to have definite numbers for catering and activities.

There is the Annual Pilgrimage to Harvington Hall on Sunday 7th September. Please think about coming along to this pilgrimage. We will be arranging a coach and there will be a list available for signing up over the next few weeks.

We have been told that the Coventry Deanery will be visited by the Bishops of the Diocese. The Visitation is an inspection of each parish and we are due to be inspected on the weekend of 15th and 16th November. We have also been asked to host the Closing Mass for the Deanery in March 2015. Nothing like a bit of notice!! Details to follow.

Fiona in the office will be away for two weeks and I will be away on the 11th August for ten days. Father Andrew and Father Tom Raftery will be able to deal with most enquiries and there will be some covering help in the office and answering the phone, but you may wish to leave booking masses etc. for the next few weeks.

I hope you continue to enjoy the summer and we pray for safe journeys for all who are travelling at this time. We also pray for all students as they await exam results.
