Dear Parishioners,

Our thanks to all those who took part in the 10 mile Sponsored Walk. We did a total of 10.8 miles and were joined by a good number of children and families for the last part of the walk. If you kindly offered to sponsor, now is the time to pay up. We will collect money after Mass and if you did sign up, please tick your name off the list. You can also drop in money at the Parish Office. The Little Sisters are a registered charity, so we can claim Gift Aid on the money if you are a tax payer. Just call in to the Parish Office or the Sacristy to sign a simple form and this will allow the Sisters to claim an extra 25% on the amount raised. Thanks to all those who helped organise and support the day. I know that people enjoyed the afternoon and we were blessed with good weather, it may encourage new members for the Walking Club. The Walking Club will continue to meet for the next three weekends. The last walk for this season will be Sunday 18th October. This week, we will meet on the Car Park at 3.00pm and take cars to Bannerbrook for a walk around Berkswell, a mere 5.5 miles!! We are happy to welcome new members to the Walking Club and will start again in the Spring.

This weekend, we have the Cemetery Blessings at Lenton's Lane. We will meet at the new car park at 3.00pm for a service of prayer and then blessing of individual graves. If there are any other graves to be blessed in some of the other cemeteries that have not been visited, please let us know and we can arrange this by appointment either at weekends or during the week. Please contact Fiona at the Parish Office to make arrangements.

In November, we are planning various events. On the 8th November we will have a Sunday afternoon meal for all our Parish helpers as a way of thanking you for all your efforts. We will have a signup sheet for this in a couple of weeks. On Saturday November 14th at the 6.00pm Mass, we will have a Remembrance Mass for all those who have died in the past year. We will light twelve candles for the twelve months that have past and will read out the names of those who died in those months. We will be writing in the next couple of weeks to all those families who have lost loved ones during the past year to invite them to the Mass. We will also have our Holy Souls envelopes available in the last two weeks of October to prepare the list of our departed loved ones, to be read out at all of the Masses during the month of November. At the end of November for the Feast of Christ the King, November 21st / 22nd, we will have an "Open Weekend" at Christ the King Church, where we will invite neighbours to come and see the Church and to have a tour and refreshments. The Youth Group will be helping with this as part of our National Youth Sunday celebrations and we will also be looking for volunteers to cover the Friday Open Day as well. 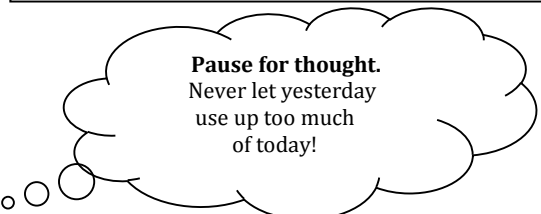
