Dear Parishioners,

This weekend we have our Pilgrimage to Hednesford. The coach is booked for 1.00pm and will return to Christ the King at 7.00pm. There are still a few places left if you want to go along. It's a lovely place to visit and it captures some of the spirit of Lourdes. The cost is £5 and we will be returning to Christ the King for 7.00pm. There are refreshments and food stalls available at Hednesford, but you are also welcome to bring a packed lunch as well.

We will have our Youth BBQ this Tuesday 7th July to mark the end of this year's activities. All our youth members from Youth Group and Youth Cafe are invited to this event. It will start at 6.30pm with food at 7.00pm. As another year draws to a close, I would like to thank Carmel and her team for all their hard work with all our young people. This weekend, they are away on an "It's a Knockout" camping weekend with other youth groups and they will also be helping with the Family Camp at the end of August. Next year they will be preparing again for Lourdes and World Youth Day in Krakow. I am sure you all appreciate how lucky we are to have such a vibrant youth ministry in the Parish.

Congratulations to Father Louis at Our Lady of the Assumption, Tile Hill. He celebrates twenty five years as a Priest this week. Congratulations also to Bishop Pat McKinney who was ordained Bishop in Nottingham on Friday and to John Paul Lyttle who was ordained a Priest on Friday night in Portsmouth. John Paul was with us as a student for the Priesthood. We had a good meeting with the Health Authority last week and we will now install a community defibrillator over the next couple of months. There will also be units available at the school and we will be looking at St Augustine's as phase two of this project. It has proved to be a life saver in emergency situations and full training will be given.

After the summer holidays we want to organise an Open Day at each of the parishes to welcome people in to our church buildings and make them aware of some of the work that we do. We will provide refreshments and tours of the churches.

There are boxes at the back of Church to support the appeals for Ghana and for school uniforms for Refugees. The regular collections of goods for Global Care Charity Shops also continue. The people at Global Care are very grateful for the continued support.

The Walking Club will meet on Sunday at 3.00pm on the Car Park. All welcome.

We are starting to plan the end of summer Family Camp. We hope to return to Packington this year and are finalizing details with the Scout Group. The Camp will be the last weekend of the school summer holidays from Friday, 28th August to Sunday 30th August. Information leaflets and booking forms are now available at the back of the Church. We need accurate numbers so will ask you to book and pay a small deposit to secure a place. Please let us have this as soon as possible and before people start to go away for the summer.

On Sunday 27th September we are planning to have a sponsored walk for the Little Sisters of the Poor and I will give you more details of this over the next few weeks. Perhaps this is something you would like to support by either doing the 10 mile walk or by being a sponsor. The schools and Youth Club have also expressed an interest in being involved and we will have some shorter distances organized so that children can join for part of the walk.

The Football Club have their Annual Gala Day next Saturday 11th July. It's a good family day out and I am sure you will want to support it!

The Holy Hour next Friday evening will start at 6.00pm rather than 6.30pm and we have been asked to offer this up for the theme of Evangelisation as there is a national conference in Birmingham, attended by all our Bishops and delegates from each Diocese looking at promoting the faith and we are asked to be united with them in prayer. The normal 7.00pm Mass will follow.

Two bits of clergy news. The Archbishop has asked me to be Dean of the Coventry Deanery. It involves looking after the Priests and Deacons in the Coventry area, exploring our Parishes can work more closely together, planning for the future and working with our Headteachers and school communities. I am happy to do this and I am sure that our own Parish will have a lot to offer to the wider Catholic community. The Office of Dean is normally for a five year period. Also, Father Andrew hopes to begin his Canon Law studies this September, which will allow for him to stay with us for a little longer. He will continue to be a big help to me, especially with this extra role. God bless.
