Dear Parishioners,

This weekend we continue our cemetery blessings at London Road and will meet at the memorial in the newer part of the cemetery for 3.00pm. We will bless the graves in that section first and then move to the very old part of the cemetery nearer town. Next week our final blessings are at Lentons Lane, again at 3.00pm and will meet at the car park.

We are making provisional arrangements with Bishop Kenney for our Visitation on the 15th and 16 November. There will be an opportunity to meet the Bishop after each of the Masses but as part of the specific timetable there will be meetings with our schools, our parish groups, parish sisters, priests, deacons local church leaders and visits to the sick and housebound. I have sent a draft timetable to Bishop Kenney for his approval and as soon as I have heard back from him I will let you have details next week. I ask that you all support us over this weekend and allow the Bishop to see the full life of the parish and the various ways in which so many of you are involved. The Visitations only occur every six years, so it is important that we give a good reflection of the life of the parish.

Pope Francis has asked our prayers this weekend for the forthcoming Synod of Bishops to treat the topic "The Pastoral Challenges of the Family". Many hope that there will be some changes in the church with regard to marriage and family life.

We will have the Holy Land reunion on Thursday November 6th in the Library. This is a little later than planned, but it avoids clashes with half term etc. Our Justice and Peace group will also host an evening and will be showing a film entitled "The Stones Cry Out" telling the story of the Christians in Palestine. This will be held on Thursday 13th November at 7.00pm in the Library. It will be very informative for all those who went to the Holy Land, as well as people wanting to become more involved in our Justice and Peace Group and some of the political aspects of the church's mission in the world.

This Thursday at 7.00pm I will be meeting with the Pastoral Care Group in the Library. If you would like to help with visiting the elderly and housebound perhaps you could come along and find out more. They do very good work and the visits are very welcome.

I have begun arrangements for the Parish trip to Lourdes next year. This will be May half term, May 23rd to May 29th. The cost will be £550. We have now secured 100 places for the trip, but these are going very rapidly and there are only five places left, ninety-five people having paid deposits, so please let us know if you want to go as soon as possible. Of course, if there is a continued high level of interest we can book another fifty people in due course.

We also have the classes for children at non-catholic schools who need to prepare for their communion and confirmation starting after half term. Our first meeting will be on Tuesday 11th November at 5.00pm in the Library and will be weekly up to Christmas and fortnightly after Christmas.

Next week we will have the Holy Souls envelopes available for the November masses. This year we will use the funds to support disabled people travelling to Lourdes in May.

In two weeks time October 18th and 19th, we will have the "Renewal of Marriage Vows" at all Masses. Please invite spouses to come along with you on that weekend. I will be using a holy water sprinkler from the site of the wedding feast at Cana, which I got this year in the Holy Land.
