Dear Parishioners,

This weekend we mark the 10<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Father Andrew's Ordination as a Priest. We had a nice get together of his family and some of his priest friends on Friday night to mark the occasion. We had a Mass for his intentions and a meal together. On behalf of the parish I presented him with a ticket to our Pilgrimage to Lourdes next year. We wish him every blessing and thank him for his work in our parish over the last three years. As you know, it's planned that he will do some Canon Law studies while remaining in our parish and I am grateful to his Bishop in Wrexham for allowing this arrangement to continue. Thanks to all at the two schools who helped with the Blessed Sacrament Procession and Picnic last weekend. We were blessed with the weather and hope people enjoyed the opportunity to process with the First Communion children and witness to our Faith.

I thought I might give an update on the World Cup Competition. We are still marking the entries. With two rounds still to go, the leading scorers are, Ruby Wainwright on 39 points, Craig Johnson on 39 points, Gavin Farrell on 35 points and then a whole group of people on 32 points. So still plenty to play for! Most people struggled with the England Group results (Group D) and the most common correct prediction was Australia 0-Spain 3.

The Pilgrimage to Hednesford will leave the car park this Sunday afternoon at 1pm. Father Andrew will lead the group.

Final payment for the Holy Land Pilgrimage is now due. A few more places have now become available (maximum four), so if anyone is interested in coming along could they contact me as soon as possible.

After the summer we will begin to get together a rota of drivers for our eight-seater bus. Anyone with a clean licence and over thirty years of age can help. If we have enough volunteers it would mean just doing it twice a year. We would offer lifts to anyone finding it hard to get to church on a Sunday. The bus will also be used for youth and school activities in the week.

I have begun arrangements for the Parish trip to Lourdes next year. This will be May half Term, May 23<sup>rd</sup> to May 29<sup>th</sup>. The cost will be £550 and we are taking names for the first fifty places. If there is demand we will then book on the next fifty. To secure a place please call in to the office with a £25 deposit as soon as possible. We can then judge the level of interest and make the arrangements accordingly.

The Talks on the Catholic Faith concluded last Wednesday. We will now take a break until September. For the next course we are looking at a DVD based set of talks, five on the bible, five on the sacraments and six on the lives of the saints. We will give further details in September when we want to start the course, which will run through to Easter 2015. Again, it will be every fortnight on a Wednesday evening.
