Dear Parishioners,
We all returned safely from Lourdes and had a most enjoyable Pilgrimage. Our Youth Group was much admired for their hard work and dedication during the Pilgrimage and we have received many letters of praise for them. Thanks to Carmel and all the team who help with this aspect of Parish life. The dedication of the young people in Lourdes is as a result of many years youth work in the Parish. Next year we may look at the walking pilgrimage to Santiago in May and perhaps, Rome, Assisi, again in September, October as part of Pope Francis' "Year of Mercy". Our thanks to Father Michael Stack for covering all the Masses and for our Deacons in making sure everything went smoothly. Our young people will also be arranging the Pilgrimage for World Youth Day in Krakow, Poland for 2016. If you are interested there is an information evening at St Osburg's, see details overleaf or speak with one of the Priests or one of our youth leaders. World Youth Day is always a wonderful experience and we are always happy to attract new young people as part of our Pilgrimage.

This weekend, we celebrate the Feast of Corpus Christi and there is a Corpus Christi Procession leaving St Osburg's at 3.00pm. All are welcome and First Communion children are welcome to wear their First Communion outfits and walk in the Procession. We have our own Blessed Sacrament Procession on Sunday, June 28th as part of the 12 Noon Mass. We will process on to the school grounds at Christ the King and there will be a chance for a family picnic afterwards. Families from Christ the King and St Augustine's are invited to this event and children again can wear their First Communion outfits for the Procession. There is a Diocesan Pilgrimage to the Shrine of Our Lady of Lourdes in Hednesford on Sunday 5th July.
