Dear Parishioners,

This week is our last full week before Lent. On Wednesday week, 18<sup>th</sup> February we begin Lent with Ash Wednesday and we have produced the annual sheet giving details of all the extra events in the Parish and in the schools which we will be arranging. We hope that you will be able to support some of these during the weeks of Lent to ensure that we are well prepared for Easter. The sheet also gives advance notice of all the Easter Mass times. We will have our Anointing for the Sick and Housebound, our Passover Meal, regular Stations of the Cross, Confessions with visiting Priests and a two day Parish Mission led by David McLoughlin who is a Senior Lecturer at Newman University at Birmingham. We will also have the early morning Masses for those on their way to work. The sheets will be available next weekend along with the Lent "Walk with Me" books and calendars.

This weekend at St Augustine's, Father Andrew will make a presentation about our future plans for St Augustine's. One way in which we want to do this is to encourage some of the new families that have moved into the St Augustine's side of the Parish and to strengthen the links between the school and church. The School is doing well and growing to a two form entry school. We will follow this up with a meeting on Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> February at 7.00pm. This weekend, we also have a suggestions box at the back of Church. Please pray for the success of this new project.

This Friday 13<sup>th</sup> February, we have a Day of Prayer for Vocations to the Priesthood and Religious Life. Each Church in the Diocese takes its turn, so there is a prayer for this intention every day of the year. There is a sign up sheet at the back of the Church. Please sign up to ensure that there is at least one person in the Church throughout the day in front of the Blessed Sacrament.

You will know that Deacon Tony Janew has undergone a major operation to repair a valve in his heart. The operation has gone very well and Tony is now at home making a good recovery. He and his family would like to thank everyone for their Mass cards, and prayers. He will be out of action for the next couple of months, after which he hopes to resume normal duties as a Deacon. At the moment he needs complete rest and I would ask that people don't visit him at home as this can be quite tiring. Please direct any enquiries about his health through the Presbytery.

Could people going to Lourdes in May collect a form from the presbytery to allow us to complete Passport details and other information for their flights. We need to start booking in flight details as soon as possible please.

very interesting. We will look at the following Saints, Benedict, Francis of Assisi, Patrick, Ignatius of Loyola, Catherine of Siena and Therese of Lisieux. This week's Saint will be St Francis of Assisi. Songs of Praise, the well known Sunday programme, is recording in Coventry at the Warwick Road United Reform Church on 10<sup>th</sup>, 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> February. A charity has asked for any unused rosaries which can be distributed in the Third World. If you have any in good repair that you are no longer using please let us have them. There is a box at the back of the Church.

As you know we have a number of funerals, especially at this time of year. If weekday Mass goes wish to leave a funeral mass after Communion that is quite acceptable as you may not wish to stay for the Eulogy or Prayers of Commendation. So please don't feel guilty to leave after Communion for practical reasons.

The Diocese is wanting to appoint a Safeguarding Assistant. This is a paid position and there are details overleaf.

The Youth Service are organising a Sponsored Cycle in July and again there are details overleaf.

Many of you like to watch the Mass on the webcam and there are details of other Churches now involved in the same scheme. We can now watch the Mass on our own TV in the Library and this will help if there is an overflow of people who want to see the Mass. Thanks to Con McHugh for doing this work. Many of the Churches in Ireland now have webcam facilities so that you may wish to watch Mass from your home town or village. Of course this does not excuse you from coming to Mass here!!
