Dear Parishioners,
 This weekend, with people throughout the Common Wealth, we will be remembering those who have died as a result of warfare with our Remembrance Sunday Masses. We will have a two minute silence at each of the Masses as a sign of respect for the fallen. There are poppies available at the back of church and we will have a poppy wreath at the altar for each of the Masses and up until Tuesday 11th November which is Remembrance Day. Our prayers for the faithful departed will continue through November and Holy Souls envelopes are still available at the back of Church. We will have a special remembrance of those who have died in the last year on the weekend of 22nd and 23rd November. We will be writing to all those families who have been bereaved over the last year inviting them to Mass over that weekend. This weekend we welcome Fr Ralph Duwell who is a friend of Fr Andrews. Father Ralph was with us last year and is a welcome visitor. He is a priest from Florida and will be with us for the next two weeks.

As you know we are welcoming Bishop Kenney to the Parish for our Visitation next weekend. His outline timetable for the weekend is as follows: arrive around lunch time. 1.30 – 3.30pm, visit some of the sick of the parish with some of the Priests and Deacons. 3.30pm, meet Headteachers and School Governors. 4.00pm, tea with various parish groups (fifteen minutes with each group to include Youth Group, SVP, Legion of Mary, Justice and Peace, Pastoral Care, Sports Groups, Mercia Club). Could any parish group leaders see me to arrange their slot between 4.00pm and 5.30pm. Also, during this time we would like him to meet anyone who volunteers in the church as a cleaner, sacristan, church warden, flower arranger, and anyone who does any of the many jobs involved in the life of the parish. If tea time on Saturday isn't good for you, there will be a chance to meet over tea after each of the masses as well. He will celebrate the 6.00pm Mass and meet parishioners afterwards over a cup of tea. 7.30pm interviewing Priests. On Sunday morning he will be at the 9.00am, 10.30am and 12 Noon Masses. After lunch, interviews with four Deacons. 4.00pm, visit Holy Rosary Convent. 4.30pm, tea with Parish Finance group. 5.30pm, review of visit with Parish Priest. 6.30pm, depart. This timetable is of course flexible but we will try to keep to these timings and could group leaders please confirm that they are able to come along. I ask that you all support us over this weekend and allow the Bishop to see the full life of the parish and the sacramental programmes.

Thanks to all those who helped with the lovely food for the Holy Land reunion and thanks to Roger Ladbury for putting together a lovely photographic record of the visit. A DVD of the trip is available for £10, with £9 going to support an orphanage in

Classes for Communion and Confirmation children at non-catholic schools will start this Tuesday 11th November at 5.00pm in the Library. Altar Servers course continues on Friday afternoons at 3.45pm – 4.45pm.

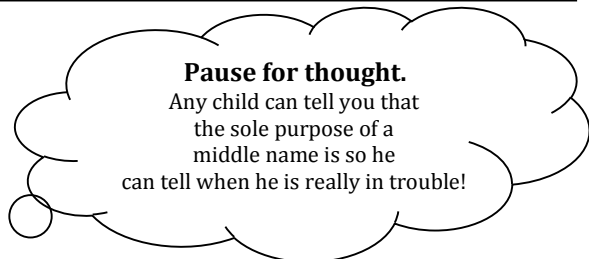
