Dear Parishioners,  
 Thanks to all those who took part in the Sponsored Walk and all those who kindly sponsored us. The sponsorship money is coming in and it looks as though we will have raised about £4,000. The Walking Club will meet again this Sunday at 3.00pm on the car park and the last walk for this season will be next Sunday, 18<sup>th</sup> October, again meeting at 3.00pm. To mark the last walk of the season we will then have something to eat in the Library at 6.00pm. All those who have walked this season are welcome. Please let me know if you are able to come so we can judge approximate numbers for catering. The Walking Club will begin again in the Spring, in time for some training for the Santiago Pilgrimage.

Thanks to all who supported the Cemetery Blessings this year. Last week's blessings at Lenton's Lane was well attended and this Cemetery is now beginning to look good and well established. In November, we are planning various events. On the 8<sup>th</sup> November we will have a Sunday afternoon meal for all our Parish helpers as a way of thanking you for all your efforts. We will have a sign up sheet for this in a couple of weeks. On Saturday November 14<sup>th</sup> at the 6.00pm Mass, we will have a Remembrance Mass for all those who have died in the past year. We will light twelve candles for the twelve months that have past and will read out the names of those who died in those months. We will be writing in the next couple of weeks to all those families who have lost loved ones during the past year to invite them to the Mass. We will also have our Holy Souls envelopes available in the last two weeks of October to prepare the list of our departed loved ones, to be read out at all of the Masses during the month of November. At the end of November for the Feast of Christ the King, November 21<sup>st</sup> / 22<sup>nd</sup>, we will have an "Open Weekend" at Christ the King Church, where we will invite neighbours to come and see the Church and to have a tour and refreshments. The Youth Group will be helping with this as part of our National Youth Sunday celebrations and we will also be looking for volunteers to cover the Friday Open Day as well.
