Dear Parishioners,

This weekend, we have the Football Gala Day and we thank all those involved with the Football Club which is such a proud part of our Parish history. Our Youth Group had a weekend camping at Packington for the Youth "It's a Knockout" event. Again, thanks to Carmel and her team for organizing this. Christ the King Youth Group came first in the senior section and second, by only one point in the junior section. We will use the same camp site for our Family Camp and the Youth leaders will be helping with the organization. Please make sure that you start to complete the application forms for the Family Camp at the end of August as we want to start finalizing details for the camp. You can email an expression of interest if you don't have time to fill in a booking form, so at least we have a rough idea of numbers. Next year, our Youth will be preparing again for Lourdes and World Youth Day in Krakow. I am sure you all appreciate how lucky we are to have such a vibrant youth ministry in the Parish.

We will soon be installing a community defibrillator at Christ the King. There will be units available on both school sites and we will be looking at St Augustine's as phase two of this project. It has proved to be a life saver in emergency situations and full training will be given.

After the summer holidays we want to organise an Open Day at each of the parishes to welcome people in to our church buildings and make them aware of some of the work that we do. We will provide refreshments and tours of the churches.

Sylvia Akomah is going to Ghana this week and is very grateful for the all the goods that have been collected for the orphanage. We will now end this collection but will continue to support the regular collection for school uniforms for Refugees. The collections of goods for Global Care Charity Shops also continue. The people at Global Care are very grateful for the continued support.

She is hopeful of making a full recovery having fractured her pelvic bone. Sister Anne has now moved to Charnwood House as she needs a little bit more care, she has settled well and of course will stay in contact with the Parish with regular visitors. Please keep them both in your prayers. If you want to arrange any visits to the Sisters, please do this through Sister Ruth first so that we ensure that they are not overwhelmed. This last week of term, there are lots of plays and assemblies and we thank staff at both schools for their hard work throughout the year. We hope that they have a good break and we pray for all students as they move up a year, especially those moving on to secondary school, college and university.
