Dear Parishioners,

This weekend we have the last of our cemetery blessings at Lenton's Lane and will meet at 3.00pm on the car park. Thanks to all who supported these blessings over the four weekends. Remembrance of the dead is an important part of our tradition and the blessings are a good reminder to us to pray for the faithful departed and to visit their places of rest. We are now making preparations for the month of November, the month of the Holy Souls and there are Holy Souls envelopes at the back of the church for you to use. Please hand in the envelopes over the next few weeks so that we can put together the Book of Remembrance which we read from during all the Masses in November. Your donations will be used to help with the sick and disabled people travelling to Lourdes next year. Thank you for your generous support with this.

We are making provisional arrangements with Bishop Kenney for our Visitation on the 15th and 16 November. There will be an opportunity to meet the Bishop after each of the Masses but as part of the specific timetable there will be meetings with our schools, our parish groups, parish sisters, priests, deacons local church leaders and visits to the sick and housebound. I have sent a draft timetable to Bishop Kenney for his approval. I ask that you all support us over this weekend and allow the Bishop to see the full life of the parish and the various ways in which so many of you are involved. The Visitations only occur every six years, so it is important that we give a good reflection of the life of the parish. It will be a good opportunity for the Bishop to meet those who he will be confirming this coming year and those involved in this year's sacramental programmes. Next week I hope to have details back so that we can arrange at what time various groups in the parish will meet with the Bishop.

We will have the Holy Land reunion on Thursday November 6th at 7.00pm in the Library. Our Justice and Peace group will also host an evening and will be showing a film entitled "The Stones Cry Out" telling the story of the Christians in Palestine. This will be held on Thursday 13th November at 7.00pm in the Library. It will be very informative for all those who went to the Holy Land, as well as people wanting to become more involved in our Justice and Peace Group and some of the political aspects of the church's mission in the world.

We had a good meeting of the Pastoral Care Group and are now working to update our records of those who need visiting and will do this in conjunction with our Eucharistic Ministers, Saint Vincent de Paul and Legion of Mary. Forms are available from the Sacristy or the parish office for all our Eucharistic Ministers and anyone who visits on behalf of the parish (SVP and Legion). Could all ministers and visitors pick up a form and complete it so that our list can be brought fully up to date.

The Talks on the Faith continue on Wednesday 22nd October and the theme will be on Confirmation.

The course for new Altar Servers at Christ the King will begin after half term. We also have the classes for children at non-catholic schools who need to prepare for their communion and confirmation starting on Tuesday 11th November at 5.00pm in the Library.

Next weekend October 18th and 19th, we will have the "Renewal of Marriage Vows" at all Masses. Please invite spouses to come along with you on that weekend. I will be using a holy water sprinkler from the site of the wedding feast at Cana, which I got this year in the Holy Land.

At the 12 Noon Mass this weekend we welcome some of our young people who will be pioneering the John Paul II Awards. This helps them to be practically involved in the Church. See overleaf for details.

Some of you will have noticed the beautiful new Book of the Gospels at Christ the King and we are grateful to an anonymous donor who paid for this. We have one on order for St Augustine's as well to avoid any "jealousy".
