Dear Parishioners,

This weekend we have the Football Club Gala Day and we pray for good weather. I thought it would be a good opportunity to thank all those involved in the football club at junior and senior level. There are not many parishes that have retained a sporting tradition and I know it is appreciated by many families and young people. Our thanks to all who work so hard, not only to put on the Gala Day, but also for work throughout the year. Our thanks also to everyone involved with the school fetes and sports days, which again were a great success. We congratulate our two primary schools on their excellent SATS results and pray for all those awaiting exam results, especially those moving on to new schools, college or employment. This is the last week of the school term and you will see that many of the parish activities will begin to take a break for the summer, so please check on the newsletter. Thanks to all our school staff and we wish them a well-earned break. There have been a few surprise results in the World Cup and our competition is still waiting to find out who the overall winner will be. There are still a few potential winners. Muireann Houston is on 39 points with a prediction of Messi and Germany still to run. Chris Ryan has 36 points with Germany still to run. Gavin Farrell has 35 points with Agüero and Argentina. We can then judge the level of interest and make the arrangements accordingly.

The Talks on the Catholic Faith concluded last Wednesday. We will now take a break until September. For the next course we are looking at a DVD based set of talks, five on the bible, five on the sacraments and six on the lives of the saints. We will give further details in September when we want to start the course, which will run through to Easter 2015. Again, it will be every fortnight on a Wednesday evening.
