Dear Parishioners,

This weekend, we welcome Sister Michaela Pirra to the Parish. Sister will be speaking at all of the Masses this weekend asking our support for the Comboni Missionary Sisters. We will have a second collection today for this appeal. This weekend, we also have the second of our Cemetery Blessings at Canley. This is where many of our parishioners are laid to rest and we will meet at the chapel at 3.00pm for a prayer service followed by the Blessing of the Graves. On the 20th September we will be at St Paul's, again at 3.00pm. We will have a Blessing at Lenton's Lane on October 4th at 3.00pm to avoid clashing with the Sponsored Walk on September 27th. We are happy to bless any other graves in other cemeteries by appointment. Let us know if you need any other graves blessing.

The details for the Sponsored Walk have now been completed and thanks to those who have volunteered to do the walk. It is only two weeks away so could you please pick up a sponsorship form from the back of the church at the weekend or from the Sacristy or Parish Office during the week. Children are also invited to take part in a shorter version of the walk and we will send out details through the school next week. The Sponsorship will all go towards supporting the work of the Little Sisters of the Poor.

Thanks to all those who came to the Youth Group on Tuesday. It got off to a really good start with 45 new members. Please encourage our young people to continue to support the Youth Group, I think they all enjoyed the first session. This week it is the turn of the Youth Café group (Yr 9 and above). They will meet at 7.00pm and again new members are always very welcome. The older group will be planning trips to Lourdes and Krakow in 2016.

We will be starting our talks on the Catholic Faith on Wednesday 23rd September at 7.00pm. These talks will be every fortnight and cover two subject areas and will have accompanying handouts. We have a full programme list, including dates and subjects available this week. We will welcome anyone considering joining the Church as well as anyone who wants to improve their knowledge of the Catholic faith. It may be of interest to non-catholic parents whose children are being Baptized, Confirmed or receiving First Holy Communion this year. You may wish to support your children on their journey of faith by becoming a full member of the Church. After half term we will start lessons for children at non-catholic schools who would like to be prepared for communion and/or Confirmation. Mrs Maggie Green will organize this course again this year. After half term we will also begin the training for new Altar Servers at Christ the King and St Augustine's. I am grateful to Michael Baldwin and Frances McManus for organizing this. Father Andrew will be recruiting new Altar Servers through the schools over the next week in time for the training course next half term.
