Dear Parishioners,

This weekend, we welcome Bishop William Kenney who has come to confirm the children from St Augustine's School and Christ the King School along with a number of children from the Parish not attending catholic schools. We congratulate all who have received the sacrament of Confirmation and thank all those responsible for preparing them. We thank the staff at both schools and our Parish Catechist, Maggie Green. We also thank parents for supporting the Passport to Faith and the Preparation for Confirmation meetings.

Next year, we may look at the walking pilgrimage to Santiago in May and perhaps, Rome, Assisi, again in September / October as part of Pope Francis' "Year of Mercy". This week we will have a meeting of our Finance Committee on Thursday 18th June in the Presbytery at 7.30pm. If you have any issues that you want me to raise at the meeting please let me know, any advice or suggestions are always welcome. This weekend, I will elaborate a little bit on the Parish Report which has been available for the last few weeks. Please take a copy if you have not done so already.

We have our Blessed Sacrament Procession on Sunday, June 28th as part of the 12 Noon Mass. We will process on to the school grounds at Christ the King and there will be a chance for a family picnic afterwards. Families from Christ the King and St Augustine's are invited to this event and children again can wear their First Communion outfits for the Procession. We will send a note home through the schools to remind parents of this.

There is a Diocesan Pilgrimage to the Shrine of Our Lady of Lourdes in Hednesford on Sunday 5th July. There is a list at the back of the Church to see if we have enough interest for a coach, leaving Christ the King at 1.00pm returning at 7.00pm. Cost approximately £5.

One of our Parishioners from St Augustine's, Silvia Akomah, will be returning to her native Ghana over the summer and would like to help an orphanage for abandoned children. We will start to collect reading books, toys, clothes and shoes for children aged 0 - 15 years. They need to be of reasonably good quality and they will be brought over to Ghana. There are boxes for the Ghana Appeal at the back of St Augustine's and at Christ the King, so that you can start to bring things to church.
