Dear Parishioners,

This weekend we are welcoming Bishop Kenney to the Parish for our Visitation. He has already arrived in the parish and will stay overnight with us. His outline timetable for the weekend is as follows: arrive around lunch time. 1.30 – 3.30pm, visit some of the sick of the parish with some of the Priests and Deacons. 3.30pm, meet Headteachers and School Governors. 4.00pm, tea with various parish groups (fifteen minutes with each group to include Youth Group, SVP, Legion of Mary, Justice and Peace, Pastoral Care, Sports Groups, Mercia Club). He will celebrate the 6.00pm Mass and meet parishioners afterwards over a cup of tea. 7.30pm interviewing Priests. On Sunday morning he will be at the 9.00am, 10.30am and 12 Noon Masses. After lunch, interviews with four Deacons. 4.00pm, visit Holy Rosary Convent. 4.30pm, tea with Parish Finance Group. 5.30pm, review of visit with Parish Priest. 6.30pm, depart. I am sure that you will welcome Bishop Kenney to the parish and of course if you wish to take the opportunity to speak with him. We have tried to make sure that he is available after each of the Masses and has the opportunity to meet those involved in parish activities.

I had a good day in Leeds last Thursday to celebrate the Episcopal Ordination of Bishop Marcus Stock. He was a Birmingham Priest and was installed as the tenth Bishop of Leeds. Please remember him in your prayers as he takes up his new post. Thanks to those who supported the Justice and Peace meeting last Thursday, it was well attended and I think people enjoyed seeing the film the "Stones Cry Out". It gave a good insight into the plight of Christians in the Holy Land. It was also a reminder to us all, that many Christians throughout the world face great dangers in practicing their faith and it should remind us how lucky we are to have religious freedom and we should not take it for granted.

Lourdes is now fully booked, but if you want to join a waiting list, please give your name in at the parish office and if there is enough interest we can arrange another group. Deacon Pat is also arranging trips to Medjugorje in June and October 2015, see poster for details.

The Talks on the Faith continue this Wednesday 19th November and the theme will be on the "The God of Scripture". Classes for Communion and Confirmation children at non-catholic schools started last Tuesday and will continue each Tuesday at 5.00pm in the Library. Altar Servers course continues on Friday afternoons at 3.45pm – 4.45pm.

Our Parish Sisters are Sisters of the Holy Rosary and some of their colleagues are working in Liberia and Sierra Leone with victims of Ebola. I would like to support them in their work and we will have an extra collection on the weekend of the 29th and 30th November which is the first Sunday of Advent. I am sure that you will be generous in responding to this crisis.

The children who are making their First Confession and Holy Communion in the coming year will have received their Passport to Faith and Rosaries as they begin their preparation for the Sacraments. Please encourage these children in their preparation and support them as they make a commitment to attend Mass each week. The Confirmation children will begin their programme of commitment in the New Year.

We will begin our Advent programme in a couple of weeks. The First Sunday of Advent is on the 29th and 30th November. We will have an afternoon of prayer for the First Sunday of Advent and there is a poster at the back of Church giving details. There will also be a Service of Anointing of the Sick and Housebound on Sunday 14th December at 3.00pm followed by a Christmas Tea. Next weekend we will have a sheet detailing all these extra activities for Advent, including an early morning Mass. We will also give advance notice of all the Christmas Carol Services, Penance Service with Confession and the Christmas Mass times. It is hard to believe that it's this time of year already.

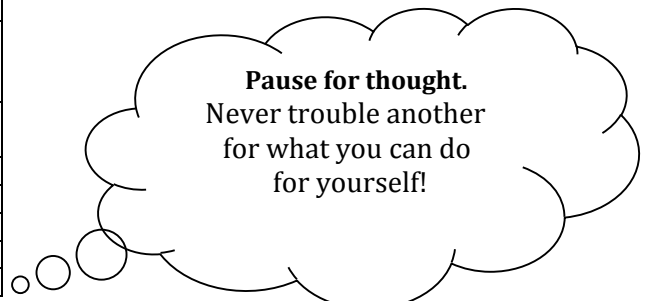
