Dear Parishioners,

This weekend, we come to the end of another school year and a busy time in the Parish. All the Parish Groups now take a break until September, so please check the newsletter to see when your groups are taking a summer break and when they restart. I want to thank all those who work so hard with the various Parish activities and we will have a get together in October just to thank all our Parish workers. I want to thank in particular, all those involved in our schools and we wish all staff and students a good break over the summer. I am sure you appreciate how good St Augustine's and Christ the King Schools are and what a wonderful opportunity they give to our young people. We think of all those moving on to secondary school, University and work and we look forward to welcoming our Year 7 pupils in September, who will be eligible for the Parish Youth Group. I will be writing to them in September. Our thanks to those who organize the School Choir and all those who help with the Children's Liturgy, these groups will take a break over the summer and will start again in September.

The Football Gala Day was blessed with good weather and the weekend went off very well and we thank all those involved with the Football Club which is such a proud part of our Parish history. Next year it prepares to celebrate its 70th year and we are grateful to all those coaches, parents and volunteers who make it such a success. This season there were three senior teams and thirty three junior teams, which as you can imagine involves a huge amount of work.

We are making preparations for our Family Camp. Please make sure that you start to complete the application forms for the Family Camp at the end of August as we want to start finalizing details for the camp. You can email an expression of interest if you don't have time to fill in a booking form, so at least we have a rough idea of numbers. We will soon be installing a community defibrillator at Christ the King. There will be units available on both school sites and we will be looking at St Augustine's as phase two of this project. It has proved to be a life saver in emergency situations and full training will be given.

After the summer holidays we want to organise an Open Day at each of the parishes to welcome people in to our church buildings and make them aware of some of the work that we do. We will provide refreshments and tours of the churches.

The Walking Club will meet on Sunday at 3.00pm on the Car Park. All welcome.

We are planning to have the Blessing of the Cemeteries again this year in September. We will have London Road on Sunday 6th September at 3.00pm, Canley on Sunday 13th at 3.00pm and St Paul's on Sunday 20th at 3.00pm. We will also arrange a time for Blessing at Lenton's Lane where there are a growing number of parishioners laid to rest and any of the smaller cemeteries by request.

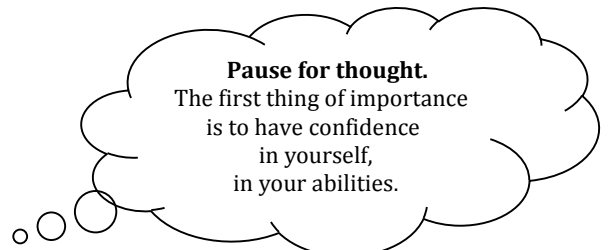
