Dear Parishioners,

This weekend we come to the end of our school year and we hope everyone has a chance for a bit of a rest and hopefully time away for a break. We thank all those involved in our parish schools and we pray for all those preparing for their new schools and those going on to college and employment. I would also like to thank all of those involved in our parish groups. These groups will now take a break for the summer and I realise that the groups are only possible through the hard work of so many volunteers. Thank you all for your generous support of the parish. We had a good Youth Group BBQ to end the year and our new youth group will start on Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> September. I will be writing to all the new year 7 pupils who will now be eligible to join the Youth Group in September and I hope that parents and older brothers and sisters will encourage them to join up. The Youth Group is very successful and a very important part of building the parish for the future. It also means that we do lose contact with our young people when they go up to secondary school. We will also be preparing our Youth Group for pilgrimages to Lourdes in 2015 and World Youth Day in Krakow 2016. The Football Gala Day was a great success and our prayers for good weather were answered. Thanks to all who worked so hard over the weekend. It ensures that the Football Club is well supported for the season ahead.

The results of our World Cup Competition are now finalised. The winner with 54 points was Muireann Houston (£100), second place was Chris Ryan with 51 points (£50), 3<sup>rd</sup> place, Ronan O'Sullivan with 45 points (£25) and 4<sup>th</sup> place, Joseph Ruddy with 42 points (£10). There were lots of others on 39 points. No one guessed James Rodriguez as the leading scorer and lots of people had Neymar and Messi as leading scorers and Argentina or Brazil as their winning teams. Thanks to all who supported the competition and the profits will be used to support the boxing club. I don't want to depress football pundits, but Muireann is not quite three, but I suspect may have got some help from her Dad!! Please pick up prize money from the Presbytery.

Final payment for the Holy Land Pilgrimage is now due. A few more places have now become available (maximum four), so if anyone is interested in coming along could they contact me as soon as possible.

After the summer we will begin to get together a rota of drivers for our eight-seater bus. Anyone with a clean licence and over thirty years of age can help. If we have enough volunteers it would mean just doing it twice a year. We would offer lifts to anyone finding it hard to get to church on a Sunday. The bus will also be used for youth and school activities in the week.

I have begun arrangements for the Parish trip to Lourdes next year. This will be May half term, May 23<sup>rd</sup> to May 29<sup>th</sup>.
