Dear Parishioners,  
 Thanks to all who helped with the Confirmations at the two churches last weekend. In spite of the weather, everything went very well and I thank all those at both schools and our Parish Catechist, Maggie Green for all their hard work. It is very encouraging to see how all of the staff at both schools support the children on their special day. We pray for these children as they prepare to move on to secondary school and I hope that they will become more active members in the Parish and take up the opportunity to be involved in such activities as our Parish Youth Group. I will be writing to them all individually as they begin Year 7, inviting them to join our group in September. On the theme of our Youth, we will have a Youth BBQ on Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> July, to mark the end of this year's activities. All our Youth members from Youth Group and Youth Cafe are invited to this event. It will start at 6.30pm with food at 7.00pm.

Next weekend, we have our Blessed Sacrament Procession and we will process after the 12 Noon Mass on Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> June from Christ the King Church, down Scots Lane to the school grounds for a simple Benediction. The school grounds will then be available for a family picnic and games for the children. We ask that this year's First Communion children from St Augustine's and Christ the King try to come to the procession wearing their First Communion outfits. We will ask them to lead the procession. When we arrive at the school, there will be rooms available for them to change out of their outfits and toilets are also available onsite. Please try to support this event which witnesses to our faith in the local community. Please bring a picnic. If the weather is bad we will still have the Mass and a simple procession inside the Church and the Library will be available for refreshments afterwards.

Next year, we may look at the walking pilgrimage to Santiago in May and perhaps, Rome, Assisi, again in September / October as part of Pope Francis' "Year of Mercy".

This week we had a meeting of our Finance Committee. I will be able to report back next week and will include a follow on from our Parish Report.

There is a Diocesan Pilgrimage to the Shrine of Our Lady of Lourdes in Hedgesford on Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> July. We will be running a coach, so please sign up if you would like to come. Cost approximately £5. Leaving at 1.00pm and returning at about 7.00pm.

One of our Parishioners from St Augustine's, Silvia Akomah, would like to help an orphanage for abandoned children in Ghana. We are collecting reading books, toys, clothes and shoes for children aged 0 - 15 years. There are boxes for the Ghana Appeal at the back of St Augustine's and at Christ the King, so that you can start to bring things to church.

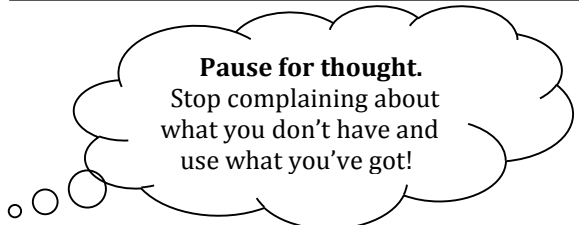
