Dear Parishioners,

It was good to welcome the Archbishop for Confirmation this weekend. It was also good to welcome his Secretary, Father Dominic Coslett. Some of you will remember that Dominic came to live at Christ the King for nine months before going off to train as a priest. I know that he felt it was a little bit like coming home. Thanks to all who worked so hard to make the confirmations a success.

During this week we have three funerals, so please pray for the deceased and their families. Thankfully, they have all had good long lives with a strong faith. We think particularly of Ellen Larkin who was just a few days short of 102 years of age. We also remember Nora Farrell and Angela Gadsby, who again were very involved in the Parish.

We had a good Parish Finance Committee meeting last Thursday and agreed to help St Elizabeth's complete their heating system and to support a teacher's salary at a girls school in South Sudan. We will look at new front doors at St Augustine's Church and consult on installing Angelus bells, as we have at Christ the King already. We will look at promoting the Gift Aid Scheme over the next week and updating the parish database to make visiting and parish outreach a little easier. After the summer we will also begin to get together a rota of drivers for our eight-seater bus. Anyone with a clean licence and over thirty years of age can help. If we have enough volunteers it would mean just doing it twice a year. We would offer lifts to anyone finding it hard to get to church on a Sunday. The bus will also be used for youth and school activities in the week.

We will have our Blessed Sacrament Procession next Sunday 29th June when we will celebrate at the 12 Noon Mass and have a procession down to the school grounds followed by a picnic. Both parish schools are invited to take part. It will be another chance for the children to wear their communion outfits and a good chance to witness to our faith. Please bring a picnic and if the weather is bad then we have the club as a fall back.

We will have a meeting about the Holy Land this Wednesday 25th June at 7.00pm in the Library. It will be a chance to meet Mr Geoff Dorrett our tour leader and to find out more information and ask questions.

The Talks on the Faith "Catholicism Made Simple" will have its final talk on Wednesday 2nd July at 7.00pm. The theme will be on "Death and Beyond". As this course comes to its end, I want to thank everyone who has been faithful to it. Next year we are looking at a DVD based set of talks, five on the bible, five on the sacraments and six on the lives of the saints.

We are arranging an afternoon for Eucharistic Ministers on Sunday 29th June at 3.00pm. Father Andrew will give a talk on the "Practicalities of ministry including; Ministry at Mass and visiting the Sick". This will be followed by a time of prayer and a cup of tea, finished by 5.00pm. Could all ministers make a special effort to attend please.
