Dear Parishioners,

This weekend we have our Blessed Sacrament Procession following the 12 Noon Mass. Weather permitting, we will process with the Blessed Sacrament to the school ground on Scots Lane and have a simple Benediction. The Procession will be led by this year's First Holy Communion children. There will be a chance for a family picnic afterwards in the school grounds. If the weather is not kind, we will have a simple Benediction in the Church and the Library will be available for refreshments.

Next weekend, we have the Pilgrimage to Hednesford and we have booked a 53 seater coach to leave from Christ the King at 1.00pm, so there are some spaces available if people want to let us know over the next week. Cost is £5 and we will be returning to Christ the King for 7.00pm. There are refreshments and food stalls available at Hednesford, but you are also welcome to bring a packed lunch as well.

We will have our Youth BBQ on Tuesday 7th July to mark the end of this year's activities. All our Youth members from Youth Group and Youth Cafe are invited to this event. It will start at 6.30pm with food at 7.00pm.

The Parish Finance Committee met last week and we are looking to improve the front of the Church at Christ the King and will present some plans for you to consider after the summer. I think they will be an improvement and will attempt to make the front of the Church more church like and focus on the theme of Christ the King. We are also working with the Local Health Authority to install a defibrillator heart machine at both Christ the King and St Augustine's. The Health Service encourage this in places where large numbers of people gather together. It has proved to be a life saver in emergency situations and full training will be given. We also looked at ways of increasing the Gift Aid contributions and ways in which other members of our community could help with Parish development. We would also like to organize an Open Day in October to welcome the local community in to the Church. We will organize tours, talks and teas for visitors.

One of our Parishioners from St Augustine's, Silvia Akomah, would like to help an orphanage for abandoned children in Ghana. We are collecting reading books, toys, clothes and shoes for children aged 0 - 15 years. There are boxes for the Ghana Appeal at the back of St Augustine's and at Christ the King, so that you can start to bring things to church. We are also looking to collect school uniforms for Asylum Seekers as we do each year. There is a box at the back of the Church for school uniforms.

The Walking Club will meet on Sunday at 3.00pm on the Car Park. All welcome.

We are starting to plan the end of summer Family Camp. We hope to return to Packington this year and are finalizing details with the Scout Group. The Camp will be the last weekend
