Dear Parishioners,

This weekend we have our Blessed Sacrament Procession led by the First Communion children. We will process at the end of the 12 noon Mass down to the school site on Scots Lane, where we will have Benediction and prayers. There will be the opportunity for a family picnic in the school grounds. If the weather is not good we will have the prayers and benediction in the church and the upstairs of the club is available for picnic lunch.

We had a nice letter from the Archbishop thanking us for his welcome to the parish and congratulating the candidates and all those whose hard work made the confirmations at St Augustine's and Christ the King go so well.

We had a very good meeting about the Holy Land trip in September. A few more places have now become available (maximum four), so if anyone is interested in coming along could they contact me as soon as possible. This weekend is the last opportunity to sign up for the Hednesford Pilgrimage which will leave next Sunday 6th July at 1pm from the car park. Please sign up on the list at the back of church so that we can decide what transport we need to organise.

After the summer we will begin to get together a rota of drivers for our eight-seater bus. Anyone with a clean licence and over thirty years of age can help. If we have enough volunteers it would mean just doing it twice a year. We would offer lifts to anyone finding it hard to get to church on a Sunday. The bus will also be used for youth and school activities in the week.

I have begun arrangements for the Parish trip to Lourdes next year. This will be May half Term, May 23rd to May 29th. The cost will be £550 and we are taking names for the first fifty places. If there is demand we will then book on the next fifty. To secure a place please call in to the office with a £25 deposit as soon as possible. We can then judge the level of interest and make the arrangements accordingly.

The Talks on the Faith "Catholicism Made Simple" will have its final talk on this Wednesday 2nd July at 7.00pm. The theme will be on "Death and Beyond". As this course comes to its end, I want to thank everyone who has been faithful to it. Next year we are looking at a DVD based set of talks, five on the bible, five on the sacraments and six on the lives of the saints. We will give further details in September when we want to start the course, which will run through to Easter 2015.

The Walking Club will be on this Sunday 29th June, meet at 3.00pm from the car park. We will drive to Browns Lane and start walk from there, lifts available.
