Dear Parishioners,
 This weekend, we will be on our Family Camp at Packington. There are about 150 people booked in and with the good weather we expect a few more to be joining us. It is a lovely way to end the summer holidays and I am very grateful to Carmel Keane and her team who work so hard each year to put it all together.

This week, the schools will be starting up again and many of the Parish groups will resume normal service. I will be writing to the Year 7 pupils who have moved on to secondary school, inviting them to join our Youth Group and would like to encourage some of the existing group members to move on to our Youth Cafe. This coming year we will be again planning for Lourdes and for World Youth Day in Krakow. The Youth Group starts up on Tuesday 8th September at 6.30pm (Years 7 and 8) and the Youth Café on Tuesday 15th September at 7.00pm (Year 9 and above).

We will also be starting our talks on the Catholic Faith on Wednesday 23rd September at 7.00pm. These talks will be every fortnight and cover two subject areas and will have accompanying handouts. We will have a full programme list, including dates and subjects next week. We will welcome any one considering joining the Church.

Next weekend, we begin our Blessings of the Cemeteries at London Road and will meet at the Memorial in the newer part of the cemetery at 3.00pm. On Sunday 13th we will have Canley at 3.00pm and on the 20th September, St Paul's, again at 3.00pm. We will have a Blessing at Lenton's Lane on October 4th at 3.00pm to avoid clashing with the Sponsored Walk on September 27th. We are happy to bless any other graves in other cemeteries by appointment. Let us know if you need any other graves blessing.

On Sunday 27th September we will have our Sponsored Walk. This will be a 10 mile walk around the lanes in Corley and Allesley. There is a list at the back of Church if you want to sign up as a walker. There is a two mile and one mile option for younger children. We will be organizing the children's involvement through the schools. We will be producing a map and details of the route. We will start at 1pm with a lunch provided at 3pm and tea and refreshments at the end of the walk. All you will need to bring is some water. There will be a recovery vehicle in case anyone finds it a bit too difficult, there will also be First Aid needs. The sponsorship will go to the Little Sisters of the Poor and there are sponsor forms available this week from the Parish Office and at the back of the Church after Sunday Mass. Please consider helping us by walking and raising sponsorship or by offering to sponsor someone. We can also have a Second Collection on the following Sunday so that you can contribute in that way as well. We will have a trial run of the route on Sunday 6th September if anyone is interested. This will help with planning and stewarding of the walk on the 27th September.

Pope Francis has issued a letter on "Protecting the Environment and the Planet". The letter is called "Laudato si" and we will have some copies of this available on the weekend of September 20th, we will also speak about the letter in our sermons over that weekend. We may also wish to consider some of the work done by our Justice and Peace Group and raising awareness of this type of Catholic action and witness.

There is a new Tea Rota available for collection in the Library and on the notice board. The Mass Book for 2016 intentions is now open.

We are now opening the bookings for Santiago which will be next May half term, Saturday 28th May to Saturday 4th June 2016. The day of departure will depend on flights. 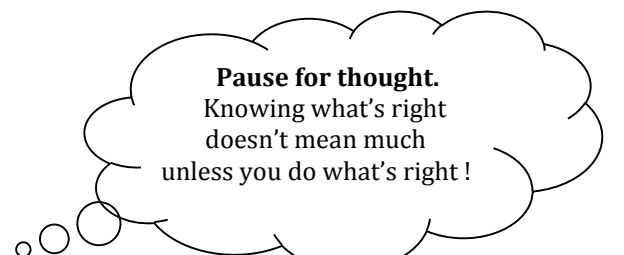
