Dear Parishioners,

Next Saturday we welcome the Archbishop of Birmingham, Bernard Longley to the parish to confirm our children. It's the first time that the Archbishop has been to our parish for confirmation. Please pray for him and all those to be confirmed at St Augustine's at the 9.30am Mass and at Christ the King at 12 Noon. This weekend at the 10.30am Mass at St Augustine's we will celebrate a First Holy Communion with Caitlin Richardson, a pupil at Tiverton School. It will be a special day for her and her family, again please keep them in your prayers.

We had a good Parish Finance Committee meeting last Thursday and agreed to help St Elizabeth's complete their heating system and to support a teacher's salary at a girls school in South Sudan. We will look at new front doors at St Augustine's Church and consult on installing Angelus bells, as we have at Christ the King already. We will look at promoting the Gift Aid Scheme over the next week and updating the parish database to make visiting and parish outreach a little easier. After the summer we will also begin to get together a rota of drivers for our eight-seater bus. Anyone with a clean licence and over thirty years of age can help. If we have enough volunteers it would mean just doing it twice a year. We would offer lifts to anyone finding it hard to get to church on a Sunday. The bus will also be used for youth and school activities in the week.

We've had a nice card and letter of appreciation from the eighteen young people from the parish and Cardinal Newman School who helped sick pilgrims in Lourdes this May half term. They were able to travel to Lourdes through your generous support of their fund raising activities.

We will have our Blessed Sacrament Procession on the 29th June when we will celebrate at the 12 Noon Mass and have a procession down to the school grounds followed by a picnic. Both parish schools are invited to take part. It will be another chance for the children to wear their communion outfits and a good chance to witness to our faith.

We will have a meeting about the Holy Land next Wednesday 25th June at 7.00pm in the Library. It will be a chance to meet Mr Geoff Dorrett our tour leader and to find out more information and ask questions.

The Talks on the Faith "Catholicism Made Simple" will continue this Wednesday 18th June at 7.00pm. The theme will be on "Right and Wrong". As this course comes to its end, I want to thank everyone who has been faithful to it. Next year we are looking at a DVD based set of talks, five on the bible, five on the sacraments and six on the lives of the saints. We will give further details in September when we want to start the course, which will run through to Easter 2015.
