Dear Parishioners,

This weekend I will be doing the Confirmations at St John Vianney Parish, so Father Andrew will be looking after the Sunday morning Masses. This week we also welcome Jason Mahoney, a student for the Priesthood from Oscott College. Jason will be arriving on Tuesday and will be with us in July and August. I am sure that you will make him welcome and we will introduce him to the Parish next Sunday. We are also having a visit from a Bishop from Eritrea. One of his Priests, Father Solomon now works in one of my former parishes of St Vincent's in Birmingham and Bishop Sukramatia wanted to come and see a larger English Parish. He will be with us on Wednesday morning. Next weekend we have the Ordination of Deacon Keith Millage. About forty people have signed up to go to the Ordination at St Chad's next Sunday. We have booked a coach which will leave Christ the King car park at 1.30pm. There is no charge for the coach which will return after the Mass and refreshments at St Chad's.
