Dear Parishioners,  
 This weekend we return from the Pilgrimages in Lourdes and Santiago. The Youth Group worked in the hospital in Lourdes and Father Andrew spent Monday to Friday with them. 35 of us walked to Santiago and remembered all of your intentions in prayer. Father Andrew was able to deliver the Lourdes petitions. We are most grateful to Fr Michael Stack, Fr Paul Burch and Fr Tony Norton for ensuring that all the Masses were covered. We are also grateful to Deacon Joe Patterson who stayed at the Presbytery and to the other Deacons who made sure that everything was covered in our absence. I hope that people had a chance to enjoy something of the bank holiday and the half term break. Things return to normal this week and all the parish groups are up and running again at the usual times.

The Walking Club will meet this Sunday at 3.00pm. We will meet from the car park and walk for 5 miles. The numbers will be lower this weekend as many will be returning from Santiago this afternoon.

We are arranging a Parish trip to Rome and Assisi from 13th November to 18th. Again, this is limited to 47 people. 37 people have already signed up, so please consider if you would like to go, as we would like to finalise this fairly soon. The cost will be approximately £625, based on two people sharing. We are now taking names and you can secure a place with a deposit of £50 at the Parish Office. We would like to now start finalising details of this trip and to allocate the last remaining places. Please decide if you would like to come as if the places aren't taken up we can offer them to people from other parishes in Coventry.

Bishop William Kenney has not been well recently. I have been asked to take on some of his Confirmations in Coventry and Warwickshire. Our Confirmations on June 18th at Christ the King and June 25th at St Augustine's will now be celebrated by Bishop Philip Pargeter.
