Dear Parishioners,

This weekend, we are distributing the "Walk with Me" booklets for Lent, along with the calendars and the parish programme for Lent. In this "Year of Mercy" it is important for us to make a special effort and especially to consider the sacrament of Confession. We will be having a Penance Service with visiting Priests as part of our Holy Week. Please use these booklets and perhaps encourage others to do the same. Lent starts this Wednesday, Ash Wednesday and you can see that we have four Masses in the Parish that day, so please make an effort to come along. You will also see that the 7.00am Breakfast Masses start on Thursday morning, again it is a good thing to do during the weeks of Lent. See the purple sheet for all the Lenten services and activities.

This year, we have events in the Deanery and in the Parish to mark the "Year of Mercy". There will be various events organized on the First Friday of each month. There will be Divine Mercy Prayers at St Mary's with Mass and the opportunity for Confession. There will be a monthly Sunday afternoon service with Evening Prayer and Confessions at St Mary's and the Church will also be made available in the week for school groups to visit. This year also marks a thousand years since the death of St Osburg and there will be celebrations to mark the anniversary on the 9th, 10th and 11th September. We will let you have details of these arrangements once they have been finalized, but this gives you some advance notice.

This week, there is a signup sheet for the trip to Oscott College on Sunday 28th February for a tour and Evening Prayer and tea. We can only bring 50 people and it will be on a first come first serve basis and the cost will be £5. Please signup only if you are certain, as there will be a demand for these places and it is disappointing if you sign for a place and don't use it. We are also arranging a Parish trip to Rome and Assisi from 13th November to 18th November. Again, this is limited to 47 people. The cost will be approximately £625, based on two people sharing. We are now taking names and you can secure a place with a deposit of £50 at the Parish Office. If there is a big demand we can look at something for spring 2017 as well. Again, this is on a

The Walking Club will start again on Sunday 14th February and will meet on the car park at Christ the King at 3.00pm. We will start with a gentle 5½ miles. We want to encourage new members to join. It is a lovely thing to do and helps with fitness. It is a gentle pace, so most people will be able to cope. Why not give it a try!

Thanks to all who supported the Calais Run. The Youth Group were able to bring lots of necessary goods to those in need. Thanks also to those who have supported the work of the Night Shelter and the Refugee shelter in Coventry. This month we will be sending off our annual donation from the green boxes, which go to support the IBBA Girls School in Sudan. All of these are important aspects of our parish life and remind us of the need of others, rather than concentration on just our parish life.

We had a good Finance and Buildings meeting during the week and I will report back on this next week.

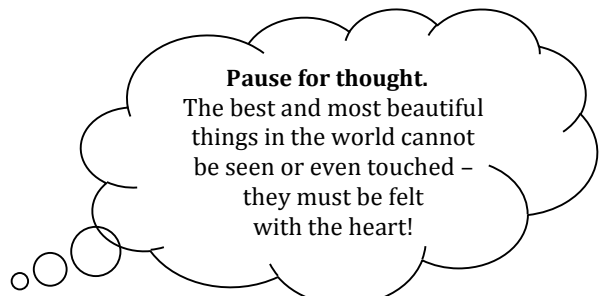
