Dear Parishioners,

This weekend we will be thinking about Vocations to the Priesthood and Diaconate. Keith Millage will be Ordained as a Deacon this Sunday at 3.00pm in St Chad's Cathedral by the Archbishop. We pray for Keith at this special time and fifty parishioners are going to St Chad's to support him. The coach to St Chad's will leave at 1.30pm this Sunday. We also welcome a student for the Priesthood to the Parish, Jason Mahoney will be with us for a month and I am sure you will make him welcome. He will introduce himself to you at the Masses this weekend and speak about his journey and vocation. There are Oscotian magazines available at the back of the Church. I will also be preaching at the Mass for Canon Peter Gilsean, who celebrates fifty years as a Priest. Next weekend, Saturday 16th July, there are three Priestly Ordinations at St Chad's.
