Dear Parishioners.

We will be celebrating the Sacrament of Confirmation over the next few weekends. Bishop Philip Pargeter will be coming to the parish on Saturday 18th June to celebrate Confirmation with the children from Christ the King School and will return again on the 25th June to celebrate Confirmation with the children from St Augustine's. We pray for all those being confirmed, for their families and sponsors.

This week we also have the Good Shepherd Mass at Holy Family Church at 1.00pm on Wednesday 15th June. I have been asked to say this Mass as Bishop Kenney is still recovering after an operation. The children from our schools will be attending, but all are welcome.

The walk to Santiago went very well and apart from a few aches and pains and the odd blister, everyone enjoyed themselves and found it a very rewarding experience. I would recommend it to anyone who wants to walk to the Cathedral in Santiago. We will probably organise something in the Parish again in a few years, but if any individuals or small groups of people are interested in the walk please have a word with me.




