Dear Parishioners,

Thanks for your support of our Lenten programme. There was a good attendance at our Ash Wednesday Masses and both schools were able to take part in Ash Wednesday masses. Our first 7.00am breakfast Mass was well attended on Thursday and these will now continue through Lent on Tuesday and Thursday mornings at 7.00am. The school's "Stations of the Cross" on Friday's at 2.30pm will take a break for the half term, but will continue again on Friday 26th February. There are still a few "Walk with Me" books at the back of Church if you didn't pick one up yet.

There is a signup sheet for the trip to Oscott College on Sunday 28th February for a tour and Evening Prayer and tea. 30 people have already signed up. There is a limit of 50 places, so please make sure that you sign up in the next week or so. Please signup only if you are certain, as there will be a demand for these places and it is disappointing if you sign for a place and don't use it. The cost is £5. We are also arranging a Parish trip to Rome and Assisi from 13th November to 18th November. Again, this is limited to 47 people. 22 people have already signed up, so please consider if you would like to go, as we would like to finalise fairly soon after Easter. The cost will be approximately £625, based on two people sharing. We are now taking names and you can secure a place with a deposit of £50 at the Parish Office.

The Talks on the Faith will conclude on Wednesday 24th February at 7.00pm and the theme will be "The Kingdom and Justice and Peace". Could those being received into the Church let us have their reception forms back as soon as possible. There are 14 people being received into Church over the Easter period. Thanks to those who helped cover the day of Prayer for Vocations last Friday, it ensured that there was someone in Church for the whole day.

The Walking Club will start again this Sunday 14th February and will meet on the car park at Christ the King at 3.00pm. We will start with a gentle 5½ miles. We want to encourage new members to join. It is a lovely thing to do and helps with fitness. It is a gentle pace, so most people will be able to cope. Why not give it a try!

Our Finance and Buildings Committee had a good meeting last week. We decided to improve the front of Christ the King Church with a new crucifix of Christ the King and new lettering, lighting and re-painting. We are looking to

improve the safety to the entrance and exit to the car park, so that cars cannot park too close to the entrance and hinder visibility. We are looking to repair the flat roof area at St Augustine's Church and to re-paint the outside of the Sports Centre. We are also looking to improve our Gift Aid Scheme and financial contributions. We are looking to establish an "Endowment Fund" which we will call the "Future Fund", to ensure that the excellent buildings and facilities that we now enjoy through the efforts of the previous generation, will be enjoyed by future generations of Catholics. We are asking people to commit to £1 a week to this fund and will let you have details in due course. We have changed the lights in the Church to LED (low energy) bulbs, which will need to be changed less and are cheaper to run. Our thanks to Matthew and Keith Millage for this. We are also going to improve the lighting in the Church toilets.

I am sure that you have heard that the Coventry Half Marathon will go passed the Church on Sunday 28th February. This mainly affects access to the car park for the 9.00am Sunday morning Mass. There is parking at the back of the Church and the neighbouring streets, but Westhill Road and Hollyfast Road will be blocked off. The roads are usually open again by the 12 Noon Mass. I am sure that you have got used to this in past years and can make plans accordingly.

Please continue to support our Lenten events and remember the details on the purple sheet. This year we especially want to promote the healing Service with the Anointing of the Sick and the services of Confession with visiting priests in this "Year of Mercy". Also remember, that this Friday is Family Fast Day and we will have a collection for CAFOD next weekend to give to those in need.

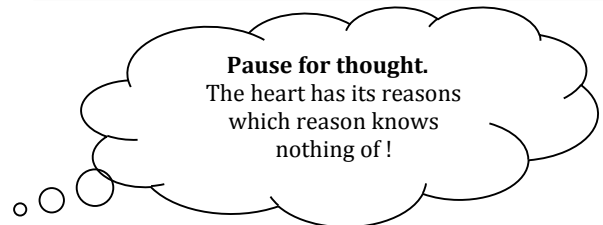
