Dear Parishioners,

This weekend we have a Pastoral Letter from the Archbishop which will be read at all of the Masses. It mentions a Novena of Prayer beginning this Friday and there are copies of the prayer available at the back of Church. The letter reminds us that our Lenten efforts this year are closely linked to the "Year of Mercy". Please try to support this Novena of Prayer. There are a few "Walk with Me" books and calendars left at the back of Church if you haven't picked one up yet. Father Andrew will be away for two weeks in Belgium as part of his Canon Law Course. He has exams and lectures over the next fortnight, so please remember him in your prayers. Father Michael Stack, the Hospital chaplain will be helping us with some of the Masses while Father Andrew is away. We are grateful to him for his help at this busy time.

The Breakfast 7.00am Masses on Tuesday and Thursday are being well attended. For those who are working, this might be a convenient time to come to an extra Mass in Lent. There is also the 7.00pm options on Monday at St Augustine's and Friday at Christ the King. Please remember there are Stations of the Cross each Sunday at 4.00pm and with the schools at 2.30pm on Friday.

The Walking Club will meet again at 3.00pm on Sunday on the car park. To avoid muddy fields, we will again walk for 5 1/2 miles around the Hawkesmill area. Next Sunday a number of walkers have signed up for the trip to Oscott, so some of the walkers may wish to come on this trip and have a walk around the grounds of Oscott as part of our tour. Those not going on the trip will still meet on the car park at 3.00pm. There is a signup sheet for the trip to Oscott College next Sunday 28th February for a tour and Evening Prayer and tea. The cost is £5, please sign up this weekend as we have to let them know the numbers this Monday.

I am sure that you have heard that the Coventry Half Marathon will go passed the Church next Sunday 28th February. This mainly affects access to the car park for the 9.00am Sunday morning Mass. There is parking at the back of the Church and the neighbouring streets, but Westhill Road and Hollyfast Road will be blocked off. The roads are usually open again by the 12 Noon Mass. I am sure that you have got used to this in past years and can make plans accordingly.

We are arranging a Parish trip to Rome and Assisi from 13th November to 18th November. Again, this is limited to 47 people. 22 people have already signed up, so please consider if you would like to go, as we would like to finalise fairly soon

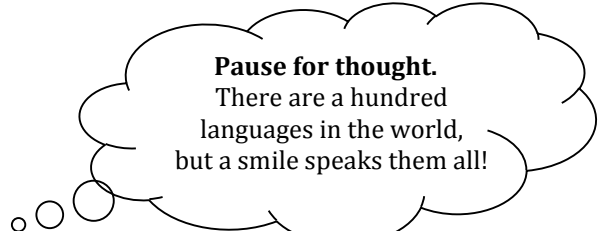


