Dear Parishioners.

This weekend we celebrate First Holy Communion with the children from St Augustine's. The children made their Communions at the 10.00am and 12 Noon Masses this Saturday. We thank all of those who have prepared the children, our teachers, our Catechists and the parents who have supported the preparation meetings and Passport Scheme so well. The children from Year 6 are now preparing for their Confirmation celebrations, on 18th June at Christ the King and the 25th June at St Augustine's. Please keep these children, their families and sponsors in your prayers. Thanks to all who helped with the Communions last week.

We have an outing for our Altar Servers this Sunday, 22nd May. We will leave the car park at Christ the King at 2.15pm for bowling at Bermuda Park for 3.00pm. Sweets and drinks will also be provided, so servers will not need to bring much money with them. If any parents are willing to help with lifts, please let us know. We hope to be back by 5.30pm and will ask children to give you a ring to be picked up from the car park.

The Walking Club meets again this Sunday at 3.00pm. We will leave from the car park and will walk for 9 miles. This will be the last walk before the Santiago Pilgrimage next Sunday, 29th May. Many of the walkers will be away in Santiago for the 29th May and 5th June, but walkers will still meet at 3pm on those days for a local walk of 6 miles. Please remember all the walkers in your prayers. We will be walking the last 100 miles of the route to Santiago (St James) to the Cathedral where St James is buried.

Our Youth Group will be travelling to Lourdes in half term to help at the hospital. Father Andrew will be joining them for five days, Monday to Friday and some local Priests will ensure that we still have the regular pattern of weekday Masses.

We are arranging a Parish trip to Rome and Assisi from 13th November to 18th. Again, this is limited to 47 people. 37 people have already signed up, so please consider if you would like to go, as we would like to finalise this fairly soon. The cost will be approximately £625, based on two people sharing. We are now taking names and you can secure a place with a deposit


