Dear Parishioners,

I would like to thank everybody for helping with Fr Clarke's Funeral Rites. There was a good attendance of Priests and people on Tuesday night and Wednesday and it was lovely that three Bishops and the Archbishop celebrated the Mass with fifty Priests. I am sure Fr Clarke would have been happy and I know his brother Brian was delighted with the support and prayers of so many people. Most of the booklets and Memorial Cards were taken, but I have left the remainder at the back of the Church for you as well as copies of my sermon at the Requiem Mass which a few people have asked for. It is also available on the website. Fr Clarke was laid to rest at Oscott College Cemetery and in due course will have a headstone blessed and erected, I will let you have details of this. If people want to make a donation in memory of Fr Clarke, this will be paid to CAFOD and can be left at the Presbytery or Sacristy. May he Rest in Peace.

The Walking Club meets again this Sunday at 3.00pm on the car park and will walk for 7.5 miles. We will leave from Christ the King car park so there is no need for cars and lifts this week. We will have a meeting about Santiago this Wednesday 27th April at 7.00pm in the Library. This will be a chance to meet up again, answer any questions and arrange payment details.

There is a Parish Finance Committee Meeting on Thursday 28th April at 7.30pm. Please let me know if there are any issues that you wish to raise about Parish finances or buildings.

We are arranging a Parish trip to Rome and Assisi from 13th November to 18th. Again, this is limited to 47 people. 37 people have already signed up, so please consider if you would like to go, as we would like to finalise fairly soon after Easter. The cost will be approximately £625, based on two people sharing. We are now taking names and you can secure a place with a deposit of £50 at the Parish Office.

Pope Francis has asked Catholics throughout Europe to have a special collection this Sunday 24th April to help persecuted Christians in the Ukraine. I am sure that you will support this generously and this gives you notice. The collection is not eligible for Gift Aid.

The Youth Group are having a Cake Sale this weekend of 23rd /24th April to help them raised funds for Lourdes. They are also arranging a Race Night on Saturday 30th April at St Finbarr's at 8.00pm. Please support them as you usually do.
