Dear Parishioners,

This week sees the start of the school holidays and many of our Parish Groups will now take a break until September. I would like to thank all of those who work so hard to lead and organise these groups. Please see the Newsletter for details of these Groups and when they will starting up again. We have the list available for the Pilgrimage to Harvington on 4th September, please sign up if you wish to go. We hope to organise a few coaches from the Deanery parishes. The Family Camp will be on the last weekend of the school summer holidays, Friday 2nd September to Sunday 4th September. There are information forms available at the back of the Church. The Deanery are also organising a Mass to commemorate 1000 years of St Osburg's. There is a Mass with the Archbishop on Sunday 11th September at 11.30am. The Mass commemorates the monastery founded in Coventry by St Osburg 1000 years ago. It is significant as Coventry can trace its roots as a City from this time. Each Parish will be asked to send representatives to the Mass. Details to follow. St Elizabeth's are also celebrating 100 years of the Church and school as well as 50 years of Good Shepherd School. There is a Mass with the Archbishop on Sunday 25th September at 3.00pm. All former parishioners and pupils are very welcome.

We are completing various bits of maintenance and improvements over the summer. The exterior of St Augustine's sports hall has been repainted and I am grateful to Brendan Malone for doing this. The grounds have been tidied up with the help of Tommy Cleary, Barney McGurk, Michael Byrne and Michael Needham and there have been repairs to the broken kneelers in Church and I am grateful to Mick Joyce and Michael Brennan. Because the buildings are so well used, it is important to keep on top of them. Over the summer there will be work on both schools. St Augustine's has received a grant to replace all the doors and windows, which will complete a programme of renovation.

Fr Tom Raftery from Maynooth will be visiting the Parish for two weeks in August. He will be here from 4th August to 16th August. I know that you will be glad to see him, fully recovered and back at Christ the King.

The Walking Club will meet this Sunday at 3.00pm on the car park and will take cars to Meriden. We will walk from the Queen's Head, so a stop at the pub at the end of the walk is a strong possibility!
