Dear Parishioners,

This weekend Bishop Pargeter will Confirm the children at St Augustine's. We pray for those receiving the Sacrament, their sponsors and families. We are grateful to Bishop Pargeter for standing in during Bishop Kenney's illness.

This week has been a very important week with the result of the Referendum and the vote to leave the EU. We pray that people will work to uniting the country and to improve the lives of all people. Please pray for those in positions of power who have difficult decisions to make.

This week we have the Feast of Ss Peter and Paul. It is a Holy Day of Obligation and it would be a good day on which to pray for the future of our country. We will have four Masses in the Parish, a 9.00am at St Augustine's and 9.15am at Christ the King. The schools will be present at both of these Masses. We will also have a 12 Noon Mass at Christ the King and a 7.00pm evening Mass at Christ the King for any one working during the day. We don't have many week day Holy Days of Obligation left, so please try to support this one.

The First Communion children from Christ the King and St Augustine's will be having Blessed Sacrament Processions and a picnic. Christ the King will lead the 12 Noon Mass this Sunday 26th June and, weather permitting there will be a picnic on the school grounds. Children are asked to wear their First Communion outfits. St Augustine's will have their Procession next Sunday 3rd July as part of the 10.30am Mass and again, will have a picnic in the school grounds. I will be at St John Vianney next weekend for their Confirmations as Bishop Kenney is unable to be there.
