Dear Parishioners,

This weekend we have produced a leaflet explaining some of the Parish finances and looking to establish a Parish Endowment Fund which we will call our "Future Fund". It will be a way for us to think about our contribution to the Parish and to plan for the future. The leaflet is produced, as next week we will be making available the Gift Aid Envelopes and it is a good chance for us to think about being a Gift Aider, if we are not one already and to think about what we give to the Church each week. Please read the leaflet carefully and think of what you can do to help.

This weekend, we have our trip to Oscott College. There are a few places left, so if anyone wants to join us, the coach will leave at 2.45pm and we will be back at 8.00pm. It is a very interesting trip with a tour, tea in the Refectory and Evening Prayer in the College Chapel with the Community.

Father Andrew continues his fortnight in Belgium. He will be back next week. He has had some exams which have gone well and continues this week with a programme of lectures. I am sure he will be praying that Man Utd. can beat West Ham in the next round of the FA Cup!!

Last week we had the funeral of Fr Sean McTernan. He was the brother of Monsignor Michael Mc Ternan who was our Parish Priest here at Christ the King for over thirty years. Fr Sean, who was nearly 90 years and Monsignor Michael, as brother Priests gave over 110 years of priestly service between them to our Diocese. May he rest in peace.

For our Red Mission Box donors, we have a simpler system, bring your Red Box to the Paper Shop at the back of Church and it will be emptied straight away for you and you can have your box back straight back. There are some Red Boxes for collection by people who dropped them in, please pick yours up.

The cost will be approximately £625, based on two people sharing. We are now taking names and you can secure a place with a deposit of £50 at the Parish Office.

Please continue to support our Lenten events and remember the details on the purple sheet. This year we especially want to promote the healing service with the Anointing of the Sick on Sunday 13th March at 4.00pm and the services of Confession with visiting priests in this "Year of Mercy", on Monday 21st March at St Augustine's and Tuesday 22nd March at Christ the King, both at 7.00pm. We also have our Lenten Talk by Jimmy Mitchell on Tuesday 8th March at 7.00pm. He is an engaging speaker and should be worth coming to listen to.
