Dear Parishioners,

This week we have a Pilgrimage to Santiago. 35 people will be walking the last section, approximately 100 miles, of the Camino de Santiago (St James) to the Cathedral where St James is buried. We will remember the Parish in our prayers and Masses during the week and please pray for a safe journey for all the walkers. Our Youth Group will be working in the hospital in Lourdes this coming week as well. Carmel Keane and some of the youth leaders will bring some of our young people to work as part of the Diocesan Pilgrimage to Lourdes. Again, they will remember you in prayer. Father Andrew will be joining them from Monday to Friday and if you have any petitions that you want brought to Lourdes, please hand them in to the Presbytery by Sunday evening at the latest as Father Andrew will be leaving early on Monday morning. Deacon Joe Patterson will be living at the Presbytery to make sure all the calls are covered and the office will be open as usual after bank holiday Monday. There will be the normal week day pattern of Masses and we are grateful to Fr Michael Stack, Fr Paul Birch and Fr Tony Norton who are celebrating the weekday Masses for us.

The First Communion celebrations at St Augustine's and Christ the King went very well over the last two weekends and thanks to all those who worked so hard to make sure it was a special moment for our children.

We enjoyed the Altar Servers bowling trip. 40 of us went bowling and I am grateful to parents who helped with the lifts.

The Walking Club will meet this Sunday at 3.00pm. We will meet from the car park and walk for 5 miles. The numbers will be lower this weekend as many are involved in the walk to Santiago.

We are arranging a Parish trip to Rome and Assisi from 13th November to 18th. Again, this is limited to 47 people. 37 people have already signed up, so please consider if you would like to go, as we would like to finalise this fairly soon. The cost will be approximately £625, based on two people sharing. We are now taking names and you can secure a place with a deposit of £50 at the Parish Office.
