Dear Parishioners,

This weekend we celebrate the first of our Holy Communion Masses. The children from Christ the King School made their First Holy Communion at the 10.00am and 12 Noon Masses this Saturday. They will assist with the Crowning our Lady's Statue at the 9.00am Mass. The children from St Augustine's make their First Holy Communion next weekend, again at 10.00am and 12 Noon. There will still be the 10.00am Mass at Christ the King next Saturday as normal. We pray for all the children making their Communion. It is always a special day and we remember them and their families.

This weekend is also Pentecost Sunday. We will be celebrating Masses with an International flavour at the 10.30am Mass at St Augustine's and the 12 Noon Mass at Christ the King. We will have Bidding Prayers in various languages representing the increasing number of people from abroad now attending Church. International flags will be brought up in the Offertory and there will be some traditional African dance. The Feast of Pentecost reminds us that whatever our language or background, the teachings of Christ can be understood by all. Kindness is a language that the deaf will always hear and the blind can always see. Our faith will always help us overcome any barriers, prejudice and division. We have an outing for our Altar Servers next Sunday, 22nd May. We will leave the car park at Christ the King at 2.15pm for bowling at Bermuda Park for 3.00pm. Could all Altar Servers sign up for this trip this weekend so that we can book the correct number of places for bowling. Sweets and drinks will also be provided, so servers will not need to bring much money with them. If any parents are willing to help with lifts, please let us know.

The Walking Club meets again this Sunday at 3.00pm. We will leave from the car park and will walk for 8.5 miles. Because we are walking from the car park we will not need any cars for lifts. Next Sunday, 22nd May will be the last walk before the Santiago Pilgrimage. Again the walk will leave from the car park and walk for 9 miles.
