We continue our Cemetery Blessings at London Road this weekend. We will meet at the Memorial in the newer part of the cemetery and then move to the older part for blessing of any graves there. This will be the last of our cemetery blessings, but if you have any graves that need blessing in any of the other smaller cemeteries please let us know and we can arrange this by appointment.

We will continue with the Monday evening service at St Augustine's, as this has been well supported. We will have a Eucharistic Service at 7.00pm as usual. Please continue to support this and the Divine Mercy prayers will also be said each month. There will be Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament from 6.30pm leading into the Eucharist at 7.00pm.

The next "Gift" meeting will be on this Thursday 5th October at 7.30pm and again on Thursday 2nd November (the first Thursdays of each month).

There will be the usual Sunday afternoon walk and we will meet on the car park at 3pm. The last walk of the season will be on Sunday 22nd October when the clocks go back.
