Last Friday we had a celebration for a number of Priests in the Coventry Deanery who celebrated various anniversaries. Fr Bernard Anwyl (Holy Family) marked sixty years of Priesthood. It was good for the Deanery to mark all of these years' service. Congratulations to all these Priests. Retired Deacon Cliff Duckett, who served for many years at Holy Family, was also ordained a Deacon twenty five years ago.

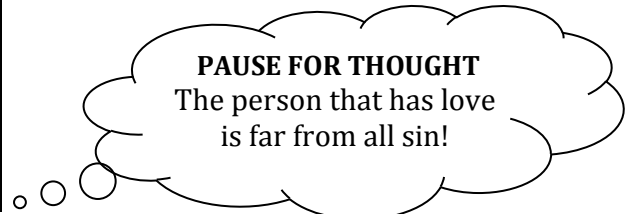
