Dear Parishioners,

This weekend we have the last of the cemetery blessings. We will meet at London Road by the War Memorial Garden in the newer part of the cemetery. We will bless the graves there first before moving on to the older part. This brings to an end the blessing of graves at the cemeteries most used by our parish families. If there are any other graves that need to be blessed, please let us know and we can arrange this for you. Thanks to all those who dropped in goods for the Calais run. There were lots of bedding, food and sleeping bags and mats which will be very helpful to those in need.

Next Sunday evening the 9th October, we have a free concert with Dan Callow and Emily Clark. They are very talented performers and I would encourage you to come along for the concert at 6.00pm. We will be giving out tickets this weekend as a reminder and you can still turn up on the night without a ticket. There are two opportunities to improve our knowledge of the Catholic faith. There is a "Sowing the Seeds" Course for the Deanery, beginning on 10th October at 7pm at All Souls Church. It will last for 12 weeks and there are details at the back of Church. We will also begin our own "Talks on the Faith" particularly for those who want to join the Church. These will begin on Wednesday November 9th at 7pm. There are details of the programme available this week at the back of Church. Why not try to come to one of these courses. They are particularly helpful for someone wanting to join the Catholic Church. The Sacramental preparation for the children making Communion and Confirmation will soon be starting again and we will write to parents of children in years 3 and 6 over the coming weeks. We will be using the Passport to Faith again this year. We will also be organising classes for children not at Catholic schools, please contact the Parish Office if you have any children who need to be prepared for First Confession, First Communion or Confirmation.

The Walking Club will meet this Sunday at 3.00pm on the car park. We will do the Meriden Dome walk, so cars will be needed for lifts please. We will meet over the next month and plan for the last walk of the season to be on Sunday 23rd October before the clocks go back and the evenings are getting dark. We will have a short walk on Sunday 23rd October followed by an evening meal together at 5.30/6.00pm in the Library. We will have the Renewal of Marriage Vows on 22nd / 23rd October. You may wish to invite non-catholic spouses to Mass that Weekend and renew vows together as part of the Bidding Prayers of the Mass.
