 This weekend we celebrate Pentecost Sunday and we will have an International Mass at St Augustine's. We will have prayers in different languages and national flags will be carried in the Offertory Procession. There will be samples of national dishes after Mass. We will also have Bidding Prayers in various languages at the other Masses over the weekend. It is a good weekend to remember the importance of diversity as the country seeks to build unity. It is also a good time to pray for our young people who will be confirmed over the next few weekends. Bishop Kenney will be visiting the Parish on Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> June to confirm the children at Christ the King and on Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> June to confirm the children at St Augustine's. Next weekend, 11<sup>th</sup> June Cardinal Newman School will be having a Cake Sale to support a trip they are organising for students to help with a project in Swaziland, Africa. I am sure you will support them generously.

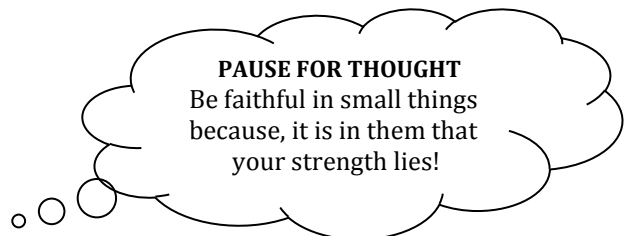

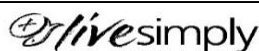
