Dear Parishioners,

This week, the Governors of Christ the King will begin the process of recruiting a new Headteacher for Christ the King Primary School. The new Headteacher will be appointed for September 2017 and we ask for your prayers as we make this important decision. I also want to acknowledge the outstanding service of Mrs Elizabeth Burnett who has served as Headteacher for over twenty years and has ensured the highest standards at Christ the King and ensured it has always been fully part of our Parish life. We will be able to acknowledge her outstanding service at the end of the school year, but I know we all appreciate her devotion to the school and Parish.

This Friday we have our Annual Day of Prayer for Vocations. Every day of the year, a different Church in the Diocese takes a turn to have a day of prayer and ours is this Friday 10th February. There will be Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament from after the morning Mass at 10.00am through to the evening Mass at 7.00pm. There is a sign up sheet at the back of Church if you can spare half an hour during the day to come and pray. Some of the children from the school will also be calling in through the day.

Our "Talks on the Faith" will resume this Wednesday, 8th February at 7.00pm and the topic will be "Baptism". The following week the Talk is on the "Eucharist" and there is also an interesting evening on the "Church and Social Media". This will be in the Library on February 15th from 7.00pm to 9.00pm. It is a good way of seeing how we can use modern means of communication in relation to our faith.

There is a new white book case on the side aisle of the Church which contains some books and resources which you can use with the children during Mass. Please return the resources to the book case at the end of Mass.

This month we will be starting to recruit volunteers for the "Good Neighbours" Scheme. It will be a chance to work in Coundon and Radford along with members of other Churches. The scheme will visit people who are often on their own and will just require volunteers to give up an hour every few weeks to visit or to even

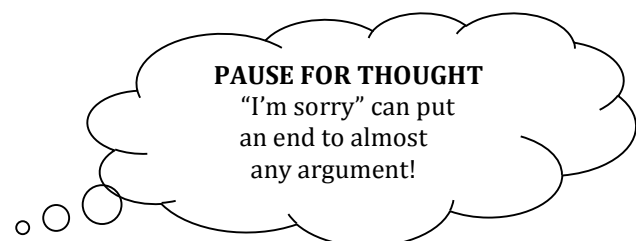
