Dear Parishioners

This weekend we welcome Fr James Mchamungu, who will be speaking at each of the masses. He is a Holy Ghost Father, the same Order that Fr Tom Raftery belongs to. He will be making an appeal to support their work on the Missions.

We have had a nice letter from Fr Andrew, thanking you all for your generous gifts to him and for the Mass and social gathering in the Parish Centre. Thanks to all those who went to the Induction Mass at Whitnash on Friday night. I know that Fr Andrew has been very touched by all the support and encouragement he has received over the years.

We will be using our Book of Remembrance at each of the Masses in November, praying for the Holy Souls. Please let us have your names for the Holy Souls list and place the envelopes in the box at the back of the Church or through the Presbytery letter box. We will end the month with a Mass for all those who have died in the past year. Families will have received letters inviting them to come to this Mass on Saturday 25th November at the 6.00pm Mass. We will read out the names of those who have died during the year and light candles in their memory.

This week we have meetings for First Holy Communion parents from Christ the King on Wednesday 8th November at 6.30pm and St Augustine's on Thursday 9th November at 4.30pm.

Next year our Parish Pilgrimage will be to Fatima. We will visit Fatima for five days from Sunday June 3rd to Thursday June 7th. We will fly from Heathrow with British Airways and the cost includes all coach transfers and travel, airfare and four nights full board at the hotel in Fatima. The price will be £500. We need to start judging numbers for the trip and these will be given on a first come basis. We have approximately 40 places available. Could you please contact Fiona at the Parish Office if you are interested in coming. We will ask for a deposit in due course to confirm your interest.
