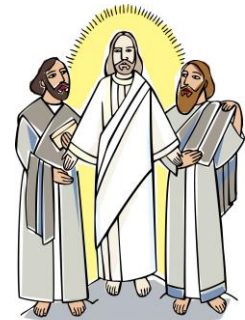
There will be the usual Sunday afternoon walk and we will meet on the car park at 3pm for a local route.
