Dear Parishioners,

This week, we began reading the names of the Holy Souls from the Book of Remembrance. We will continue to read these names at every mass during the month of November and the Book of Remembrance will be placed in front of Our Lady's Statue in the Church. The envelopes for the Holy Souls are still available at the back of the Church and can be placed in the Holy Souls box or posted through the Presbytery letter box. We will also have a Mass of Remembrance for all of those who have died over the last year on Saturday 26th November at the 6.00pm Mass. The Bereavement Group will be sending out letters inviting relatives of those who have died over the last twelve months. These letters will be sent out this week.

This Tuesday 8th November, the Deanery will have a Mass at St Mary's for all the deceased Clergy who have served in Coventry. The Mass will be at 7.00pm followed by a buffet and a chance to meet the Priests and Deacons of the Deanery. At Mass the names of all the deceased Clergy from Parishes around the City are read out at the Bidding Prayers. Please try to come along. It is also a chance to visit the "Door of Mercy" as the "Year of Mercy" comes to a close.

This week we start the children's preparation for Confession and Holy Communion. There are parents meetings this week and the children will explore the theme of "Prayer" and be presented with rosary beads at next weekend's Masses. At those Masses we will have our Remembrance Day commemorations with a minutes silence and poppies will be brought up in the Offertory Procession. Cardinal Newman School will lead the Liturgy at the 12 Noon Mass.

Over the next few weeks we would like to promote some worthwhile local projects and give people the chance to volunteer and work with other Churches. The Winter Night Shelter will open again in December and St Osburg's will host this on a Wednesday evening throughout the winter. If you would like to volunteer to help with the Night Shelter, there are three shifts, evening, night-time and morning.
