Dear Parishioners,
This weekend we will be celebrating First Holy Communions at St Augustine's and we congratulate the children and their families. Next Saturday there will be another First Communion Mass at St Augustine's again at 10.00am. Because Fr Andrew is back, there will be a 10.00am Mass and Confessions at Christ the King this coming Saturday. The Christ the King children will make their Holy Communions on Saturday 20th May at the 10.00am and 12 Noon Masses. There will be no Confessions and Holy Hour on that day.

If you are wanting to go to Walsingham, this is the final call for the coach. We have booked coaches to depart from St John Fisher and Christ the King at 8.00am next Saturday May 13th.
